

Creating spaces of experience: learners' diary meeting 5 in Brussels – June 20th-22nd 2012

The fifth meeting took place in June 2012 in Brussels (Belgium). It was the last meeting for the partners of the project "Creating Spaces of Experience".

The meeting was divided into two days, and very different activities:

- The first day was dedicated to a meeting in Eupen: the meeting took place in the Ministry of the German-speaking Community, where we met people from the Belgian german-speaking National Agency. We received a lot of information about the management of the Belgian National Agencies. In the afternoon, the partners were invited to attend workshops about, for example, the most relevant elements that should acquire a learner, or methods of training.
- On the second day, the meeting took place in Brussels. Some new workshops were proposed to the partners, experimenting new methods of training. The afternoon was dedicated to the formalities to be completed before the end of the project.

The last meeting of the project was the opportunity to learn new methods of training but was to the opportunity to meet people from different origins, cultures, languages. The project can allow to create new training methods for learners/trainees but it is obvious that we learnt too from the other partners.

In addition, it underlined that we must pay attention to people who can be considered as "different" (people living far away from the usual way, people from different backgrounds, disabled people...). Indeed, our organization could adapt its courses to those people thanks to the methods acquired during the project.
